Financial Support for Families

FAMILY SUPPORT OPTIONS

- CSEF –provides payments to eligible students to attend camps, sports and excursions. Families holding a valid means-tested concession card or temporary foster parents are eligible to apply and a special consideration category also exists.
- Bellaire PS runs a Second hand Uniform sale once per term uniforms are donated and sold for a gold coin donation to our Student Wellbeing Program which can then provide new or used uniform or pays for camps & excursions etc for students from disadvantaged families in our school community.
- State Schools Relief may cover the cost of new school uniforms, shoes, books and more for disadvantaged students. Parents or Carers who require assistance need to make an appointment with the school to discuss their situation.
- Local community supports such as Rotary, Lions Club of Highton, St Vincent de Paul and the Salvation Army provide financial assistance, scholarships and bursaries to needy families in our school community. Access to these supports is available through referral from the Student Welfare Coordinator.

CONSIDERATION OF HARDSHIP

Bellaire Primary School makes every effort to keep the cost and number of items that need to be purchased to a minimum. We try to ensure that the costs are affordable for all parents. Any families that are having difficulty making payments please make an appointment to speak with our nominated parent payment contact person, Kate Matthews (Business Manager) to discuss possible support options and flexible payment arrangements. Any information about your financial circumstances, payment arrangements or status will be kept strictly confidential and only shared with relevant school personnel.

PAYMENT ARRANGEMENTS AND METHODS

Bellaire Primary School accepts the following payment methods:- Cash, cheque, BPay, QKR or EFTPOS.

The school appreciates that families may sometimes experience financial difficulties in meeting request for payments and contributions. To further assist parents with payments, four payment options have been developed:

Option A Full amount when ordering the booklist online (Preferred option)

Option B Full Payment at the beginning of Term 1

Option C Part Payment at the beginning of each Term or half yearly (beginning of Terms1& 3)
Option D Other payment arrangements (please contact the office to make other arrangements).
